#### **Christian Hills Update**

Contractor cutting and filling and prepping for construction.

#### Sports Arena Update

Changes orders coming:

Irrigation for both fields, the skating rink, and the future splash pad, along with a new drinking fountain to cost \$145K. Other costs also include irrigation system and plumbing work within the concession stand not included.

To paint the current building will cost more than \$250K. We are waiting for a quote to only paint the sandstone color of the current Rec Center.

The storage room equipment closet was \$61K versus \$8K-\$10K for a cage.

Landscaping cost to be added by \$25K – \$40K.

Horizontal white line to be added to the new building, waiting on quote.

#### Public Works Committee Meeting

Cameras in the building about \$65K but doesn't include labor, wiring, server, or software which could be another \$60K. This figure also does not include a computer software or updates on website.

#### Lake Lorin Update

Work is done in the bottom of the lake and clean up along with grading the area between the ledge rock and the path.

Final stages are sodding and path restoration should be completed by Halloween if not before then, just in time for the Turkey Trot.

#### MFT Project Update

2023 MFT Bid was yesterday, expected cost was \$300K-\$400K but bids received were higher so might do sections of streets along with only doing sections near curb to stretch budget to be within \$380K-\$400K.

#### Audit Update

#### Waste Management Contract

This will be on the next Village Agenda for approval to enter into contract with Waste Management.

#### Public Works CBA

CBA is there with a 3-year contract and 2% increases each year.

#### **Police Department CBA**

We are still in negations with the Police in regards to renewing their CBA.
